Jason was born with Poland Syndrome, a condition that causes underdeveloped muscles on one side of the body, and in Jason it caused him to have a missing pectoralis major, or chest, muscle on one side as well as an underdeveloped hand and fused fingers. Jason's family was overwhelmed by his diagnosis. They left most doctor offices in tears because they were told to "figure out how to live with his condition" or to try therapy, which was too expensive.

They then learned about **Any Baby Can's Early Childhood Intervention** or ECI program. After two years in the program and having therapy at home, Jason is an active, confident toddler and Jason's family is confident about what the future holds for him.
